

Integrated Pest Management Notice to Parents

As part of an Integrated Pest Management program, Texas ISD has a policy that requires the use of nonchemical pest control tactics whenever practical. However, pesticides may periodically be applied.

The district applies only pest control products that comply with state and federal guidelines. All persons performing Pest Management at this district are required to receive special training in current pest management practices and pesticide application. Except in an emergency, signs will be posted 48 hours in advance prior to an indoor application. For outdoor applications, we will post at the time of treatment and leave up for 12 hours.
